Three men (two young, the other middle-aged) bicker, banter and argue but it is hard to define the relationship between them. Then it becomes clear that the young men are lodgers. However, it also becomes apparent that they are part of a terrorist organisation . . .

This is a play which almost defines the term 'thriller'. As a result of its tight, witty script, moments of pure hilarity are juxtaposed with superbly realised instances of tension.

As chilling as it is humorous, this is a must for those who like their theatre cogent and absorbing. (Dawn Kofie)
