Paul Sellar's follow-up to the acclaimed 2014 crime caper *The Moonflask* is a gritty two-part thriller that cements his place within the vanguard of the genre. Meanwhile, Robert Glenister (above) packs a punch as likeable bruiser Joe in a role that fits him like a glove.
